











(iii) Resolution: 3













After a detailed discussion the following resolutions have been made in the Board of Studies meeting, February, 27, 2017

(i) Resolution: 1 The board unanimously resolved that there is no change in the existing Curriculum.

(ii) Resolution: 2 In order to meet the growing demand for teachers of English, the curriculum includes a project on "On-The-Job Training" for students as teachers. The students teach in neighboring schools for about 21 working days in the afternoon session and submit a report. Based on the report submitted, viva voce examination is prescribed for evaluation of the performance.

In this way, the students obtain training and get their communication skills improved. They get a sense of satisfaction by doing service to the society. Other options available are;

1. Front office Management in Hotel Industry.
2. Guide in the Department of Tourism.
3. News reading in Radio channels.
4. Report Writing in Journalism, etc.
5. Marketing as a means to develop communication skills.
6. Content writing in various multinational companies.

(iii) Resolution: 3 The board unanimously suggested that the Part IV paper, "Value Education" may be taught in English and the Exams written in English, since it will be useful not only for the English Literature students, but also for the students who have Hindi as their Part I paper.

The Saints of India, may be prescribed as the text to be taught.

(iii) Resolution: 4 It is resolved to approve the enclosed list of the examiners for both question paper setting and central valuation.
