


DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The members of Board of Studies in chemistry met in the Committee Room of our College on 28.10.2017 at 10.00 a.m. and discussed about the changes to be made in the syllabi of the existing courses of both UG and PG programmes and the following are the minutes of the meeting:














1. It has been decided to merge the Non-Major Elective courses, Solid State Chemistry - I & II in semesters III and IV respectively into a single Non-Major Elective course - I viz. Solid State Chemistry to be offered to II B.Sc. Physics students in semester-III.
2. In semester-IV, instead of Solid State Chemistry - II, a new Non-Major Elective course - II viz., Health Awareness and Management has been introduced and this course is open for all disciplines of II year UG students.
3. It has been decided to carry out the required minor changes in the UG syllabus in the next board meeting.
4. It is proposed to introduce the activity based academic learning in the continuous internal assessment by incorporating this component for 10 marks instead of 20 marks given to assignment alone at present. For PG programme, 10 marks may be given to this activity component, 10 marks for seminar and 10 marks for assignment instead of 15 marks each to seminar and assignment allotted at present.
5. The scheme of examination of the UG programme was modified to incorporate the above changes.
6. The new panel of examiners for both UG and PG practical and theory examinations has been approved.
7. The above changes will be effective for the students admitted from the academic year 2018-19 onwards.
8. It is resolved to extend the Advanced Research Instrumentation Centre (ARIC) facilities by the way of Knowledge Sharing, sample characterization and conducting certificate course on "Instrumentation Techniques" at subsidized rates to the students of the colleges which executed MoUs with our college.



The Board of Studies Meeting of the Chemistry Department was held on 09.03.2018 at 10.00 a.m. to finalize the syllabi for both UG and PG programmes and following are the minutes of the meeting.

1. It has been decided to continue with the present syllabi without any modification for the students who are already undergoing B.Sc degree programme.
2. Decided to continue with the same syllabi for the courses of 1st year M.Sc degree programme for the students to be admitted from 2018-19.
3. A proposal has been accepted to replace the course Corrosion Principles Protection and Monitoring (Course code: 13PCH3EL3) in IInd year M.Sc degree programme with a new course on Computational Chemistry.
4. Decided to place the syllabus for the Computational Chemistry course in the next meeting.
5. The syllabi of the B.Sc (Chemistry) first year courses namely General Chemistry-I, General Chemistry-II and Core Practical-I have been revamped and the Outcome Based Education component has also been included. This is applicable to the students who are to be admitted from the academic year 2018-19 onwards.
