


DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

Minutes of the Board of Studies meeting held on 22-02-2019

1. There is no change in the existing syllabi and scheme of examinations of semesters V and VI of UG Chemistry programme for the students admitted during the academic year 2016-17.
2. There is no change in the existing syllabi and scheme of examinations of semesters I and II of UG Chemistry programme for the students admitted during the academic year 2018-19 onwards.
3. The revised scheme of examination and syllabi of semesters III and IV under outcome based education for the students admitted during the academic year 2018-19 onwards.
4. A value added course on "Chemistry for competitive examinations" is introduced in the Semester V of the UG Programme with online evaluation for the students admitted during the academic year 2017-18 onwards.
5. In the allied practical course offered to the UG students of Department of Physics in semesters III and IV instead of qualitative organic analysis, physical chemistry experiments have been introduced. This will be applicable for the students admitted from academic year 2019-20 onwards.
6. There is no change in the existing syllabi and scheme of examinations of semesters III and IV of PG Chemistry programme for the students admitted during the academic year 2018-19.
7. The elective course on "Corrosion principle, protection and monitoring" offered in Semester III of the PG programme has been replaced with a new core course "Computational chemistry" and will be offered in Semester IV for the students admitted during the academic year 2019-20 onwards. The core course "Physical methods in chemistry- II (Analytical chemistry)" has been renamed as "Elective -Analytical Chemistry" and will be offered in Semester I of PG programme.
8. The elective courses, Polymer chemistry, Organic reactions and reagents, Green & aminochemistry and medicinal chemistry have been reshuffled. These changes will be applicable for the students admitted in PG programme from academic year 2019-20 onwards.
9. The revised scheme of examination of the PG programme has been passed in the board and will be applicable for the students admitted from academic year 2019-20 onwards.
10. Objective type questions in Part A will be introduced in the UG as well as PG programmes for the students admitted from academic year 2019-20 onwards.



