MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING - 02.12.2020

The Board of Studies of B.Com (Commerce) of Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore-20, commenced at 2.00 P.M. on 02.12.2020 through Google Meet (Online).

The Board passed syllabus for the students admitted from 2020-2021 onwards:

The following New courses are introduced in the syllabus:

- 1. Fundamentals of Accounting First semester.
- 2. Public Finance Second semester.

The following courses have been shifted from one semester to another semester:

- 1. Environmental Studies First semester to Second semester.
- 2. Value Education Second semester to Fourth semester.
- 3. Business Communication Fourth semester to Third semester.

The following courses are revised in the syllabus:

- 1. Principles of Accountancy (Unit I) in the First semester
- 2. Financial Accounting (Unit II) in the Second semester
- 3. Principles of Marketing (Unit V) in the Second semester
- 4. Principles of Management (Unit IV) in the Third semester
- 5. Company law and Secretarial Practice (Unit V) in the Fourth semester
- 6. Banking Theory law & Practice (Unit III) in the Fourth semester
- 7. Cost Accounting (Unit III, IV) in the Fifth semester
- 8. Entrepreneurial Development (Unit II) in the Fifth semester
- 9. Business Research Methods (Unit V) in the Fifth semester
- 10. Management Accounting (Unit III) in the Sixth semester
- 11. Indirect Taxation (Unit IV) in the Sixth semester
- 12. Human Resource Management (Unit V) in the Sixth semester

The following points were discussed in the Board meeting:

- For UG Programmes, the maximum credit limit may be fixed from 140 to 150 and the maximum marks may be fixed from 3600 to 3900.
- "Environmental studies" and "Value Education" are to be offered as off-calendar instructional courses, in Second and Fourth semester respectively with two credits each.
- The revised Programme Objectives and Programme Specific Objectives are to be passed.
- Evaluation pattern comprising of 50 Marks Internal and 50 Marks External is to be passed for UG Programmes.
- 20% of the syllabus in each course has been devoted to self-study. In our department decided to allot Unit-V for self-study. Students may learn the content through online resources.
- The percentage of content modification of each course may be mentioned in the minutes.
- Courses may be planned in the fourth semester for Credit Transfer if possible.
- Students of B.Com, B.Com (CA) and B.Com (PA) are given freedom to choose faculty members from various streams of Commerce for the courses "Commercial Law" in Semester-III & "Company Law and Secretarial Practice" in Semester-IV.
- The board empowers the chairman to make any changes if necessary.
