### கருத்தரங்கத்தின் நோக்கம்

தமிழக வரலாற்றில் கி.பி. ஐந்தாம் நூற்றாண்டு முதல் பன்னிரண்டாம் நூற்றாண்டு வரையிலான காலகட்டத்தைப் பக்தி இயக்கத்தின் பொற்காலம் எனலாம். அக்காலகட்டத்தில் நாயன்மார்களும் திருமுறையாசிரியர்களும் ஆழ்வார்களும் தோன்றி சைவ வைணவக் கொள்கைகளை மக்களிடம் பரப்புரை செய்தனர். அவர்கள் அருளிச்செய்த பாக்கள் பன்னிரு திருமுறைகளாகவும் நாலாயிர திவ்வியப் பிரபந்தங்களாகவும் விளங்கி மக்களிடம் பக்தியை ஊட்டின. திருமுறையாசிரியா்களும் ஆழ்வாா்களும் அருளிச் செய்த பதிகங்கள்/பாசுரங்கள் சிலவற்றின் கடைப்பாடல்கள் கவனத்திற் கொள்ளப்பட வேண்டியவை. அக்கடைப்பாடல்கள் சைவ மரபில் 'கடைக்காப்பு' என்றும் வைணவ மரபில் 'பயன்தலைக் கட்டுதல்' என்றும் வழங்கப்படுகின்றன. பக்தியுடன் ஓதியுணர்தல் என்னும் தன்மையில் மட்டுமல்லாது சமூகவரலாறு, பண்பாடு, தத்துவம், இசை, மொழிக்கூறுகள், யாப்பு, மெய்யியல் வாழ்வியல் நெறிகள் போன்ற பல்வேறு விடயங்களும் அவற்றில் உள்ளடங்கியிருப்பதைக் காணமுடிகிறது. கடைக்காப்புப் பாடல்கள் குறித்துச் சிந்திக்கவும் உரையாடவும் செய்தால் தமிழ் இலக்கிய வரலாற்றெழுதியலுக்கு வாய்ப்பாக அமையும் என்ற நோக்கத்திலும், பன்னிரு திருமுறைகளையும் நாலாயிர திவ்வியப் பிரபந்தங்களையும் மக்கள் இன்னும் தெளிவாக ஓதியுணர வழிவகுக்கும் என்ற நோக்கத்திலும் தமிழ்த்துறை இக்கருத்தரங்கத்தைத் திட்டமிட்டுள்ளது.

It is important for everyone at every stage of his life as it helps us to handle stress, relate to others and make choices.

Many factors contribute to mental health problems and it affects the cognitive, emotions and behaviour of

people of all ages. Statistics states that, around 450 million are mentally disturbed throughout the World and in India it is around 10 to 15% of the people and the number is on the rise every year. It is predicted that around 650,000 people are affected in Tamil Nadu Due to the stigma associated with mental illness, the affected person hesitates to seek medical help Around 800,000 individuals commit suicide every year and most of them are between 15 to 44 years of age.

Government of India introduced National Menta Health Care Act, 2017 and District Mental Health programme under National Mental Health Programmes for the promotion of Mental Health. The field of Mental Health opens lot of avenues for the intervention of social workers at different capacities. This Seminar intends to institute awareness on Menta Health and its paradigm shift.
