வணக்கம், கோயம்புத்தூர் ராமகிருஷ்ண மிஷன் வித்யாலயம், கல்விப் பணியோடு பாரதத்தின் அறம்சார் வாழ்வியல் முறைகளையும் போற்றி வளர்த்துவரும் கல்வி நிறுவனமாகும். சுவாமி விவேகானந்தர் சிகாகோ சர்வமத மகாசபையில் உரையாற்றி 125 ஆண்டுகள் நிறைவடைந்ததையொட்டி இவ்வாண்டு வித்யாலயம் பல்வேறு நிகழ்வுகளை நடத்தி வருகின்றது. அந்நிகழ்வுகளுள் ஒன்றாக வித்யாலயத்தின் ஓர் அங்கமான ஸ்ரீராமகிருஷ்ண மிஷன் வித்யாலய கலை அறிவியல் கல்வூரித் தமிழ்த்துறை **“சனாதன தர்மம்”** என்னும் பொருள்மையில் தேசியக் கருத்தரங்கத்தை வருகின்ற செப்டம்பர் மாதம் 19 ஆம் நாள் (19.09.2019) நடத்தத் திட்டமிட்டுள்ளது. இக்கருத்தரங்கம் சிறக்க சான்றோர் பெருமக்கள் தங்கள் மேலான பங்களிப்பையும் ஒத்துழைப்பையும் நல்குமாறு அன்புடன் கேட்டுக்கொள்கிறோம்.

கருத்தரங்கின் நோக்கம்

சுவாமி விவேகானந்தர் 1893 செப்டம்பர் 11ஆம் நாள் சிகாகோவில் நடைபெற்ற சர்வமத மகாசபையில் கலந்துகொண்டு உரை நிகுத்தினார். மேலும் அமெரிக்காவின் பல்வேறு பகுதிகளிலும் ஐரோப்பிய நாடுகளிலும் உரையாற்றினார். வரலாற்றுச் சிறப்புமிக்க அவ்வுரைகள் இந்தியாவின் பண்பாட்டையும் வாழ்க்கைமுறையையும் உலக நாடுகளுக்கு எடுத்துரைத்தன. ஆன்மீகமே பாரதப் பண்பாட்டின் அடிப்படை. மனிதகுலத்தை உயர்நிலைக்கு அழைத்துச் செல்ல ஆன்மீகம் இன்றியமையாதது. பாரதம் அதனை உலகிற்கு அளிக்கும் என்பது சுவாமி விவேகானந்தரின் துணிபு.

தனிமனித விருப்பு வெறுப்புகள், மதம், மொழி போன்ற வேறுபாடுகளைக் கடந்து மனித இனம் கடைபிடித்து ஒழுக்கத்தக் அறிவியல் அடிப்படையிலான வாழ்வியல், ஆன்மீகக் கொள்கைகள் சனாதன தர்மம் என்ற பொதுப்பெயரால் அழைக்கப்படுகிறது. அக்கொள்கைகளை வெளிப்படுத்தும் நோக்கில் இக்கருத்தரங்கம் நடத்தப்படுகிறது.

கருத்தரங்கச் சிந்தனைக் களங்கள்

சனாதன தர்மம் என்பது குறிப்பிட்ட ஓர் இனத்திற்கோ, மகத்திற்கோ, மொழியினருக்கோ மட்டும் உரிய தர்மமல்ல. அது மனித இனம் முழுமைக்குமான ஓர் அறிவியல் அணுகுமுறையிலான வாழ்வியல் எனலாம். அதுனுள் எண்ணற்ற கூறுகள் இருப்பினும் கீழ்க்காணும் சில முக்கியமான கூறுகளை மட்டும் இக்கருத்தரங்கம் தனது சிந்தனைக் களங்களாகக் கொள்ளுமெகிறது.

- சுவாமி விவேகானந்தர் பாரதத்தின் ஆன்மீக வாழ்வியல்முறையை உலகளவில் எடுத்துச் சென்றவர் ஆவார். சனாதன தர்மம் மனித வாழ்வின் மேன்மைக்கு இன்றியமையாதது என்பது அவருடைய கருத்து. உலக மக்கள் யாவருக்கும் பயன்படும் வகையில் அவர் அதனை அனைவருக்கும் உரிய வகையில் கொண்டு சேர்க்க வேண்டும் என்று விரும்பினார். அதற்கு அவர் முன்மொழியும் வழிமுறைகள் குறித்து இக்கருத்தரங்கத்தில் சிந்திக்கப்படவுள்ளன.
- எந்தவொரு வாழ்வியல்முறையும் அறிவியல் அடிப்படையிலமைந்து தனிமனிதனுக்கும் சமூகத்திற்கும் பயனளிப்பதாக இருக்க வேண்டும். சனாதன தர்ம வாழ்வியல்முறையினால் வளர்ந்துள்ள தனிமனித, சமூகப் பயன்பாடுகள் இக்கருத்தரங்கில் சிந்திக்கப்படவுள்ளன.

- தனக்கென மட்டும் வாழாமல் பிறர்க்கெனவும் வாழும் வாழ்வு உயர்வாழ்வு. சனாதன தர்மம் இதனை “சேவை” என்று வலியுறுத்துகின்றது. பாரத இலக்கியங்கள் யாவும் இதனை அறிவுறுத்துகின்றன. குளம் வெட்டுதல், மரங்களைக் காத்தல், சோலைகள் அமைத்தல், கல்விச்சாலைகள் அமைத்தல், பசித்தோருக்கு உணவிடல், நலிந்தோரைப் பேணல், நோயுற்றோருக்கு உதவுதல் போன்ற அடிப்படை அறநெறிகள் ஒட்டுமொத்த மனித சமூகத்தினையே எவ்வாறு உயர்த்துகின்றன என்பது நினைவுகூர இருக்கின்றன.

- தமிழ் நீதி இலக்கியங்களான திருக்குறள், நாலடியார், ஆசாரக்கோவை போன்ற நூல்கள் வாழ்க்கை நெறிமுறைகளைப் போதிப்பவை. வாழ்வில் அன்றாடம் கடைபிடிக்க வேண்டிய அறங்கள், பழக்கவழக்கங்கள் போன்றவற்றை அவை விவரிக்கின்றன. பெரியபுராணம், பெருங்கதை போன்ற காவியங்கள் கதைவடிவில் அத்தகைய வாழ்வியல்முறைகளை எடுத்துரைக்கின்றன . அவற்றைக் குறித்த சிந்தனைகளும் நிகுத்தப்படவுள்ளன.

- மனிதகுலத்திற்குத் தேவையான வாழ்வியல்முறைகளும் தத்துவ வளர்ச்சியும் சனாதன தர்மத்தின் கூறுகள். அறிவும் ஆராய்ச்சியும் இணைந்து செயல்படும் வாழ்க்கை நெறிமுறைகள் குறித்துச் சிந்திக்கப்படவுள்ளன.

- கோயில்கள் பாரதத்தின் அடையாளமாகவே அமைந்துள்ளன. கோயில்கள் வழிபாட்டுத் தலங்களாக மட்டும்மல்லாமல் சமூகக் கூறுகளையும் கலைகளையும் தன்னகத்தே கொண்டுள்ளன . பள்ளிகளாகவும், நீதிமன்றங்களாகவும், அபித்துக் காலங்களில் மக்கள் தஞ்சம்புகும் இடங்களாகவும் கோயில்கள் உள்ளன. இசை, நடனம், சிற்பம், ஓவியம் எனக் கலை வளர்க்கும் கூடங்களாகவும் அவை இருந்துள்ளன. சனாதன தர்மத்திற்கு அவற்றின் பங்களிப்பு குறித்து விவாதிக்கப்படவுள்ளது.

- பிரம்மச்சரியம், கிருஹஸ்தம், வானப்பிரஸ்தம், சந்நியாசம் என்னும் வாழ்க்கைப் பழினைகள் சனாதன தர்மத்தின் அடிப்படையாகும். அவற்றின் நோக்கம், சிறப்பு, தேவை முதலியன நினைவுகூர இருக்கின்றன.

- மனித வாழ்வு இல்றாம், துறவறம் என்று இரண்டு அறநெறிகளில் பயணப்படுகிறது. அவ்வாழ்வியல் முறையின் போக்கு, குறிக்கோள் போன்றவை பாரத அறக்கோட்பாடுகளின் வழி சிந்திக்கப்படவுள்ளன.

Commemoration of the 125th Anniversary of Swami Vivekananda's historic address in Chicago, Department of Tamil, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore organized a national level seminar on "Sanadhana Dharma" on 19.09.2019 at G.K.D.

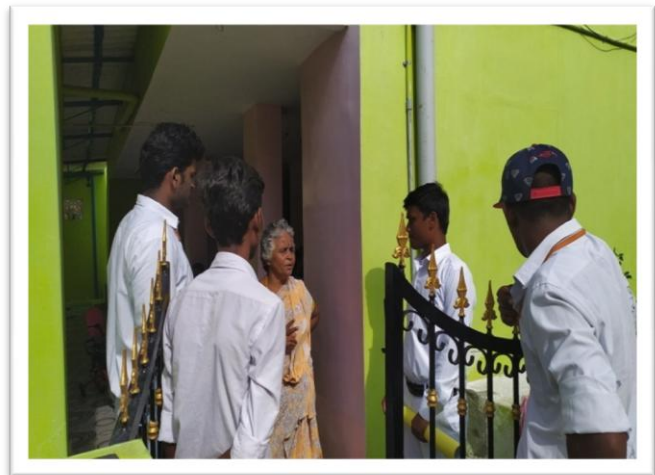

REPORT

- ❖ Discuss the most recent advancements, trends, concerns as well as challenges encountered and solutions adopted in the various fields of chemical research and other allied areas.

Inaugural Function (9.30 – 10.30am):



The inauguration of the conference RTC’20 commenced with the invocation. Rev. Swami Anapekshananda Maharaj, Correspondent, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya Polytechnic College, Coimbatore, conferred the benedictory address. The chief guest Dr. V. Kolandai Velu, Founder, Peruse Lab, USA, inaugurated the conference and released the conference proceedings. In the inaugural speech, he highlights the scientific developments of computer-aided algorithms, artificial intelligence, machine learning, and cheminformatics and its application in medicinal chemistry.



Technical Session-I (10.45am-12.45pm):

In the Invited Talk-I, Dr. S. Ravi, Professor and Head, Karpagam Academy of Higher Education spoke on the topic 'Recent developments in Phytochemistry'. The lecture elaborated the fundamental aspects of extraction, purification, characterization, biological evaluation of natural products. He also discussed some of his research works on isolation and evaluation of cinnamoylated chloroquine analogues, and N-substituted rhodamines for their anticancer and antimalarial activity.

The invited talk –II delivered by Dr. R. R. Chidambaram, General Manager, Process R& D, Sami Labs, Bangalore on the topic 'Flow Chemistry'. He briefed the technological aspects of flow chemistry and its advantages over traditional processes. He claims that the increased safety, improved product quality, cost efficiency, and overall production flexibility are drivers for the growing use of continuous flow chemistry and chemical industries increasingly adopting this technology.

**Technical Session-II (1.30-3.45pm):**



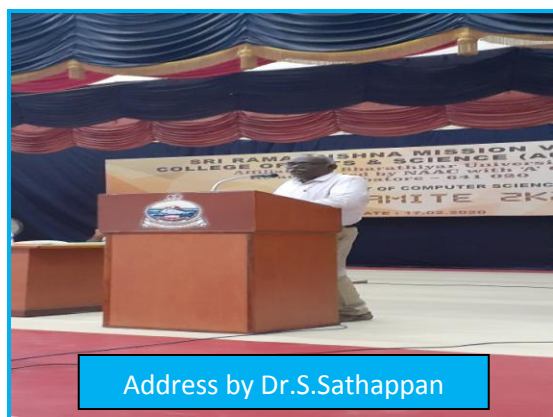

The Inaugural Session started with a prayer song. Dr. R.Sridhar, Director (Unaided Wing) of the College welcomed the gathering.



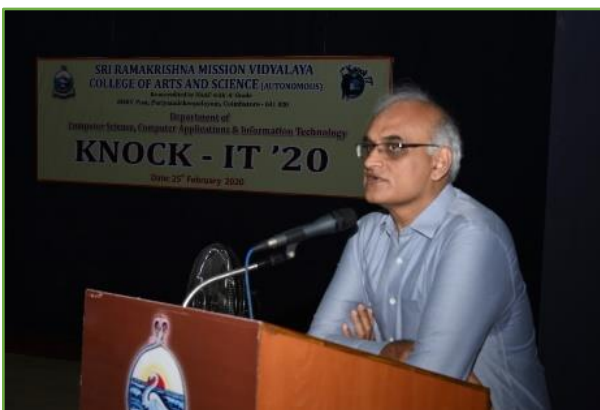
