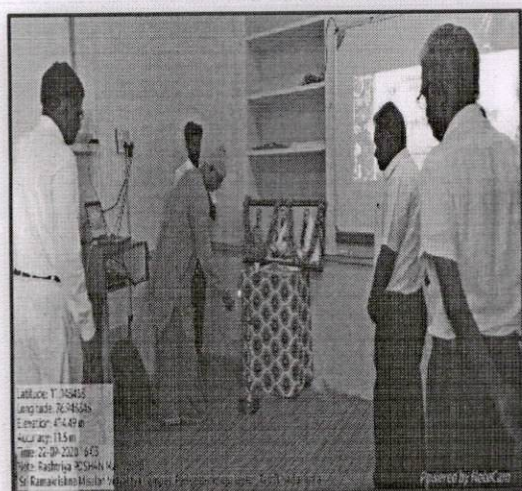

Rashtriya Poshan Maah 2020 for the children on 22.09.2020 at the College of Education campus.

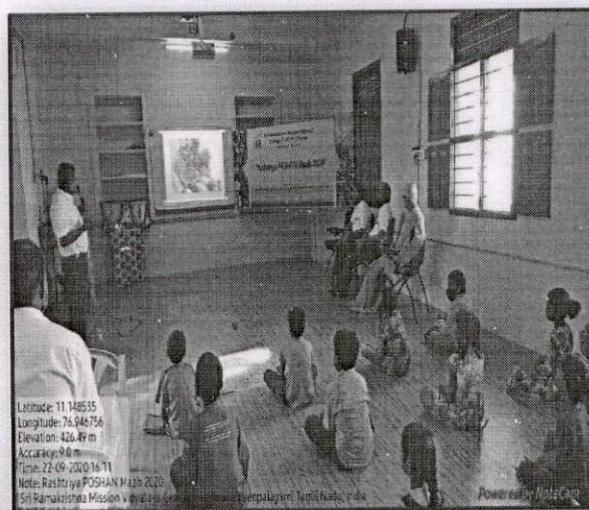

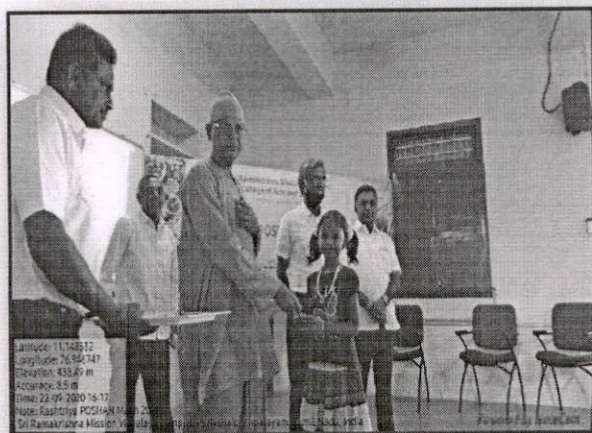

Dr. K. Kandappan, Dean, Student - Support Services of the College and

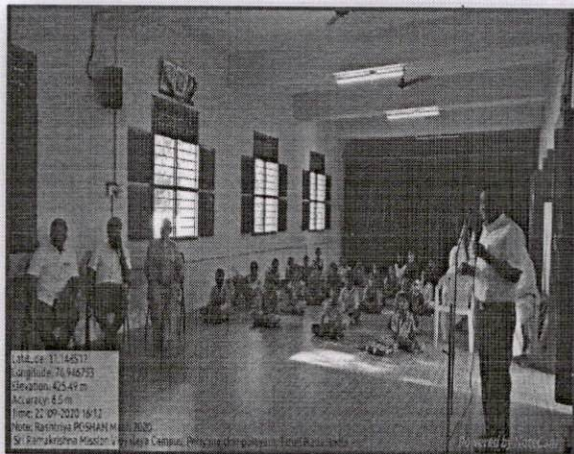

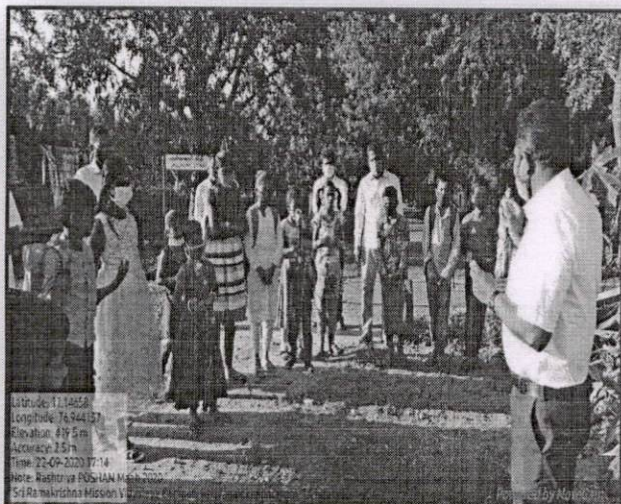
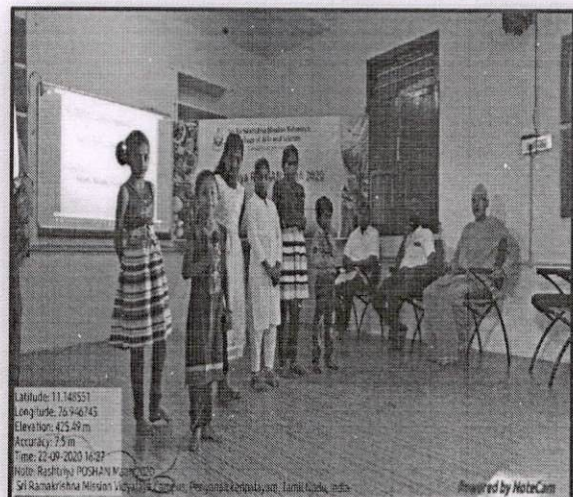

The resource person created awareness through presentation and discussion and conducted practical sessions and

demonstrations to involve the children in the making of the ground and planting of seeds.

Awareness

He has explained the significance of health and nutrition to the children. His explanation consisted of the nutrients, vitamins and minerals received through food and its functions on promoting health. He has



mentioned the vegetables and fruits in which rich carbohydrate, protein, various vitamins and minerals like calcium, phosphorous, iron and potassium are available.

Very significantly the usefulness of nutritional garden, types of nutritional

garden and the methods of preparing ground for different seeds of vegetables were elaborated. Children were inculcated with the techniques of field preparation, planting and maintenance.

Distribution of seeds

The children were given with seeds to plant at their home and were instructed to note down the growth of the seed on a continuous basis. They were told that visit will be made by the resource person and the faculty members of the department at the end of a month to monitor the growth of the seed.

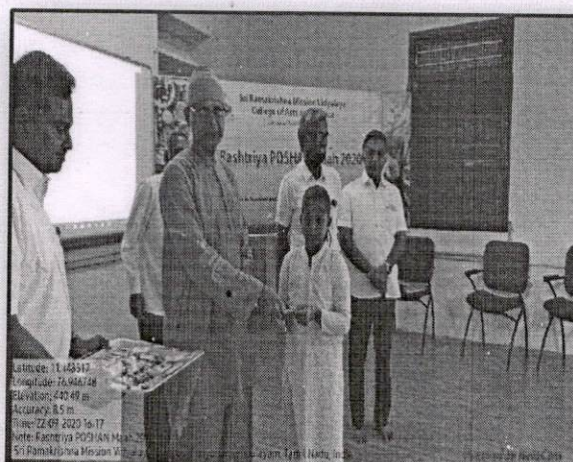


Practical and demonstration

Ten children had articulated the benefits of various fruits and vegetables. They have shown their fullest interest and involvement




by asking various questions. Their questions were answered and doubts were clarified by the resource person. 25 children had participated in the programme.

So far, more than 300 M.Phil. and 70 Ph.D. degrees were awarded. The department has published more than 700 research papers in SCI indexed international journals. During the last five years, the department has carried out five major research projects to the tune of 1.2 Cr. funded by UGC, DST and DRDO. It is a FIST sponsored department having advanced research instrumentation facilities.

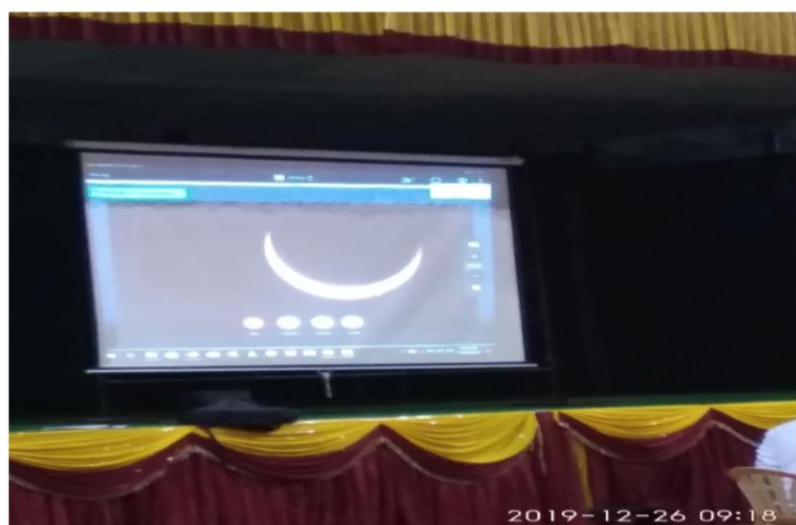
Objectives

Students had good interaction and enthusiastically raised many questions on eclipse and were clarified by the scientist.



He emphasized the importance of Annular Solar Eclipse which forms a “Ring of Fire” which is totally visible in Coimbatore region. He said that the Coimbatore region people are lucky enough to see the giant rare astronomical event on this day which is happening once in a 75 years. Astronomical telescope was arranged in the campus for the public and the students to view the eclipse directly.



The Professors of SRMV College of Arts and Science, Former scientists Dr. George IGCAR, Dr. Newton, BARC also participated. Live telecasts of eclipse from local sight, Srilanka and Singapore were shown. School children, college students, faculty members, and the local public were benefited.



Dr.K.Sasthishkumar, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics, SRMV CAS, delivered the vote of thanks.

Outcomes

The students were able to understand the following,

1. Scientific facts related to a solar eclipse such as shadow, the rotation of the moon, and rotation of the earth
2. The sun, moon and earth must be aligned in order for solar eclipse to occur

Clouds eclipse annular ring in Coimbatore

Skywatchers Dazzled By Rare Ring Of Fire Which Was Visible For A Few Seconds

Weather played spoilsport in Coimbatore on Thursday morning during the annular solar eclipse, with the spectacle being visible only for a little more than a minute in all.

It was expected that the annular eclipse would be visible for three minutes from 9.26am to 9.31am. However the skies were cloudy for most part of the morning, and the eclipse was seen only intermittently for a few seconds. At the Regional Science Centre in the city, where officials had made arrangements to view the astronomical spectacle, the eclipse was visible for around 10 seconds at 9.21am, for around 12 seconds at 9.34am and for around 50 seconds at 9.35am. Around 83% of the sun was eclipsed by the moon.

The eclipse, however, was visible in outer areas of the city such as Madukkarai, Chettipalayam and Karumathampatti.

J R Pashaniaswami, district science officer, Regional Science Centre, Coimbatore, said the ring was visible at 9.29am. "But we could see it only as a white ring. The clouds had reduced the light's intensity," he said.

To view the eclipse safely, the officials had arranged sun filter goggles, telescope, sun stands and ball mirror projection mechanisms. "While overall the event was underwhelming, nature didn't disappoint people. We were able to see the annular ring for at least over a minute in total," he said.

SOLAR ECLIPSE

More than 1,000 people had gathered at the Regional Science Centre to witness the eclipse. Families, school children and members of the public not only from the city but also from Pune, Baroda and Bengaluru have come to the centre to see the rare phenomenon.

Shrinivas Pandharipure, who had come to the city from Pune along with 10 members of his family, said he got to see the eclipse for a few seconds. "But I'm happy that we got to see what we came all this way for," he said.

S Umashathi, an industrialist from the city, who had come to witness the eclipse, said he had witnessed a solar eclipse when he was a teenager in West Bengal around 30 years ago. "This is the second time that I'm witnessing it. I saw the ring when clouds cleared for a few seconds," he said.

Others, meanwhile, were disappointed. G Adarsh, a Class V student at a city school, who had come along with his family to witness the eclipse, said he didn't get to see it.

Vigyan Prasar, the science forum under the department of science and technology Government of India, along with other forums has arranged sky watch at five places in the city, while other science enthusiasts and forums had also arranged events. They had planned to conduct a series of experiments based on the eclipse, but due to the cloudy weather, only a few could be carried out.

The next time solar eclipse in India is in June 2020, in Haryana and Punjab. In South India it would be visible next in May 2031, in Madurai and Thani, said Pashaniaswami.

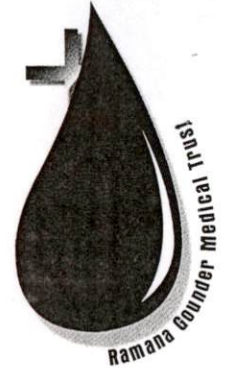
