
Objectives

The Department of Physics, Science Forum of SRMV College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore, Breakthrough Science Society, Chennai and AES Technologies, Coimbatore, jointly organized an eclipse viewing program for the public and students on 26-12-2019 at Venkatakrishna Indoor Stadium, Periyanaickenpalayam, Coimbatore. Swami Nirmaleshananda Maharaj, Secretary, SRMV CAS inaugurated the event. Dr.J.Chandrasekaran Head, Department of physics, welcomed the gathering. Dr.R.Thangavel, Principal, SRMV CAS, presided over the function.



Dr.R. Venkatesan, Head, Radiological & Environmental safety division, Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research (IGCAR), Kalpakkam, gave a lecture and explained the progress of eclipse lively. He emphasized the importance of Annular Solar Eclipse which forms a "Ring of Fire" which is totally visible in Coimbatore region. were cloudy for most part of the only intermittency for a few seconds, people from all walks of life gathered at different locations to watch the occade's last annular



eather played spollsport in Coimbatore on Thursday morning dur-ing the annular solar eclipse, with the spectacle being varible only for a little-more than a minute in all. It was expected that the annular eclipse would be visible for three minutes from 9.25sm to 9.21am However the skies were cloudy for most part of the morning, and the eclipse was seen only internit-teering for a few seconds. At the Regional Science Centre in the city, where officials had made ar-

rangements to view the astronomical spectacle, the eclipse was visible for around 10 seconds at 2 Tiam, for around 12 seconds at 9.34am and for around 50 seconds at 9.38am. Around 83% of the sun was exlipsed by the moon.

J R Pashaniawami, district science officer, Regional Science Centre, Coimbatore, said the ring was visible at 9.28mm. "But we could see if only as a white ring. The clouds had reduced the light's intensity." he said.
