



II day on 15.11.2021



III day on 16.11.2021



V day on 18.11.2021



VI day on 19.11.2021



Thangavel, Principal, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Arts & Science, Dr. K. Kandappan, Dean, Student-support services of the College and the faculty members of the Department of Social Work were present.

Resource Person

The resource person was Mrs. S. Sheela, Child Development Project Officer, Integrated Child Development Scheme, Periynaickenpalayam Block, Coimbatore.

The resource person created awareness through her wonderful and talk and discussion.



Awareness



She has started her talk by mentioning the reason behind the foundation of the Rashtriya Poshan Abhiyan. She has concentrated on the iron, zinc deficiencies normally faced by women and children, need of concentrating 1000 days during pre and post-natal periods and insisted the addition of at least one fruit, one vegetable and spinach in food to supplement carbohydrate, protein and vitamins.

She has elaborated the food to be given to the child / children during their first 1000 days. The first 270 days starts from the conception are quite important since the child in the womb gets nutritional supplements through the food intake of mother. The next 180 days, i.e first six months of child birth, only mother's milk has to be given and the next 550 days, smashed solid food should be given. Feeding mother's milk can be continued up to two years.





Tips given

She has suggested that the height and weight of the children should be measured every month to monitor their growth, the vaccine chart should be strictly adhered to and requested the participants to associate closely with Integrated Child Devleopment Scheme (ICDS) of their vicinity to receive health updates and to receive the services of ICDS. She has asked the participants to have variety of foods in their daily meals whenever possible.

Participants

Forty-three women working in Vidyalaya were the participants. Their interest in protecting their children health is shown through their questions. All queries were answered by the resource person.


