Covid – 19 Vaccination Drive (September 3 to 5, 2021)

The Disaster Management Centre of Department of Social Work organized a series of COVID-19 vaccination drive in Karamadai Block. Swami Trilokatmananda, Swami Mahamantrananda and Swami Brahmanyanda, Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Coimbatore inaugurated the camps on the below mentioned dates.

7 day Covid-19 Screening Camp (September 13 to 20, 2021)



The Disaster Management Centre of the Department of Social Work, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Arts & Science and the District Administration, Coimbatore jointly organised 7 day Covid Screening Camp between 13th and 20th September, 2021.

In the camp, 557 students including staff members of Swami Sivananda Higher Secondary School (boys and girls), Vidyalaya High School, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya Maruti College of Physical Education and Vidyalaya Staff quarters people were screened.



Five COVID positive cases were found and all are medically treated as-per government proceedings.

Kerala Flood Relief Work (20.10.2021)

The heavy rainfall in Kerala has badly affected some areas of the Kottayam District. In coordination with Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Coimbatore and Disaster Management Centre of Social Work Department, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Arts and Science undertook primary relief activities in Mundakayam and Koottickal Village Panchayats on 20th October 2021.



The relief work materials were distributed in the presence of **Swami Narayanananda**, Secretary, Institute of Agriculture and Rural Development, Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Coimbatore. Totally 687 members of 250 families were benefited.

Free Ortho & General Medical Camp (12.12.2021)

The Disaster Management Centre of the Department of Social Work & BRJ Ortho Centre & MAK Hospital, Coimbatore jointly organised a Free Ortho & General Medical Camp on 12th December, 2021 at college campus.

The camp was inaugurated by **Swami Thathbhashananda**, Secretary,

Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya Polytechnic College in the presence and blessings of **Swami Garishthananda**, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya and **Swami Nirmaleshananda**, Secretary, SRMV CAS.

Dr. BRJ Sathish Kumar, Chairman, BRJ Ortho Centre & MAK Hospital with his team of 15 members provided the medical service.



In the camp, a total of 168 participants (100 male, 67 female and one child) were benefited. Blood pressure and random blood sugar were screened for all participants. Bone density was screened for 124 participants. Free medicine was provided to the required beneficiaries. Nine MSW students and the faculty members of the department coordinated the camp.



Cardiology - Free Testing and Consulting Camp (26.12.2021)

The Disaster Management Centre of the Department of Social Work and Sri Lakshmi Medical Centre and Hospital jointly organised “Cardiology - Free Testing and Consulting Camp” on 26th December, 2021 at college campus.

The camp was inaugurated with the blessings and presence of **Swami Garishthananda**, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya and **Swami Nirmaleshananda**, Secretary, Sri Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya College of Arts & Science.



Dr. Paneerselvam, Cardiologist, **Dr. Arun**, General Physician of Sri Lakshmi Medical Centre and Hospital with their team provided the medical service.

A total number of 139 people benefited among them 89 male, 49 female and 01 children. Blood Pressure, Random Blood Sugar, Electrocardiography (ECG) and Echo Test were taken for all the needy people.
