

Report of the Panel Discussion on

“Suicide Prevention: Need of the Day and the Role of Social Workers”

The Department of Social Work organised a Panel Discussion on “Suicide Prevention: Need of the Day and the Role of Social Workers” on September 10, 2020 **in association with Tamil Nadu People’s Mental Health Forum, Chennai** to observe World Suicide Prevention Day.

The programme was conducted to promote awareness on causes and consequences of Suicide and the role of social workers in preventing it.



Dr. K. Shanmugavelayutham, Convenor, Tamil Nadu People’s Mental Health Forum, Chennai and a prominent alumnus of the Department was the moderator. Dr. A.T. Jotheeswaran, Technical Officer (Epidemiologist), WHO, Geneva, Dr. V Jaikumar, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychiatry, Institute of Mental Health, Chennai and Dr. A Shahin Sultana,

Professor, Department of Social Work, School of Social Sciences & International Studies, Pondicherry University were the panellists.



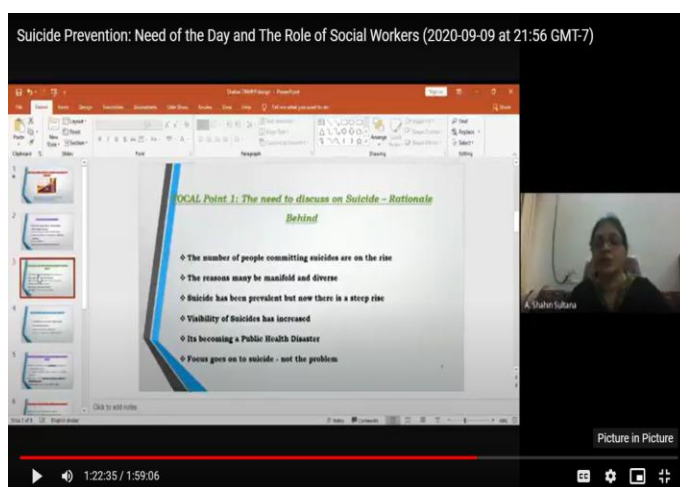
Dr. A.T. Jotheeswaran spoke on “Suicide Prevention: An Emerging Global Mental Health Priority”. He has deliberated on the global overview of suicide, global public health policy, discussions of World Health Assembly 2013 where

member countries heavily debated on suicide and passed resolution to combat it, good health and well-being goal of Sustainable Development Goals, need for evidence based research from low-income countries, need for interventions for suicide and its approval mechanism from WHO, reasons for mental health gap and highlighted the usefulness of MHGAP intervention guide for mental, neurological and substance use disorders in non-specialized health settings.



Dr. V Jaikumar spoke on “Suicide Prevention among Students”. He has elaborately explained about the risk factors of suicidal behaviour, sources of strength to be gained, actions to be carried out in preventing suicide and usefulness of various activities and therapies. He urged the participants to take note of the warning signs of suicide

and request them to listen, empathize, affirm, direct, enlist and refer to handle people with suicidal ideation. He has mentioned the available suicide help-line numbers and apps for prevention, significance of integrated and collaborative work of many people and departments and very importantly the role of media.



Dr. A Shahin Sultana spoke on “Role of Social Workers in Suicide Intervention and Prevention”. She has made the participants to understand the rationale behind the discussion of suicide, roles of social workers, conditions of youth suicide in educational institutions, field level realities, need for evidence based practice in social work and social work models to prevent suicide.

Nearly 310 participants from various parts of the country participated in the panel discussion via Google Meet and YouTube. The panel discussion proved its worthiness as many participants expressed their happiness in attending the programme.

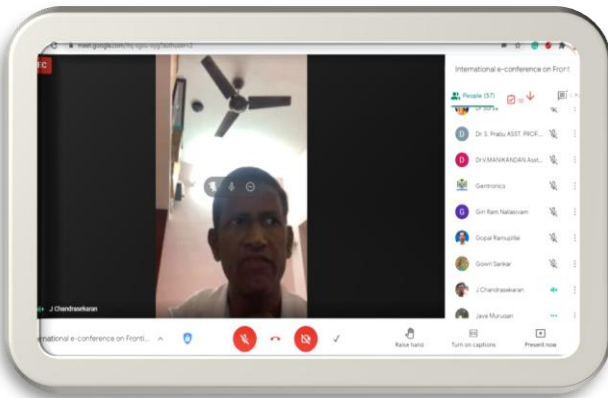

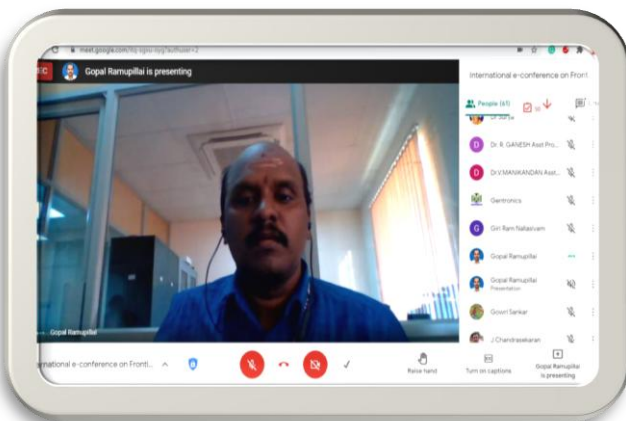
“International e-Conference on Frontiers of Energy Efficient Materials and Devices”

Dr. J. Chandrasekaran, Head and Associate Professor of Physics briefly explained the Dynamics of the conference.

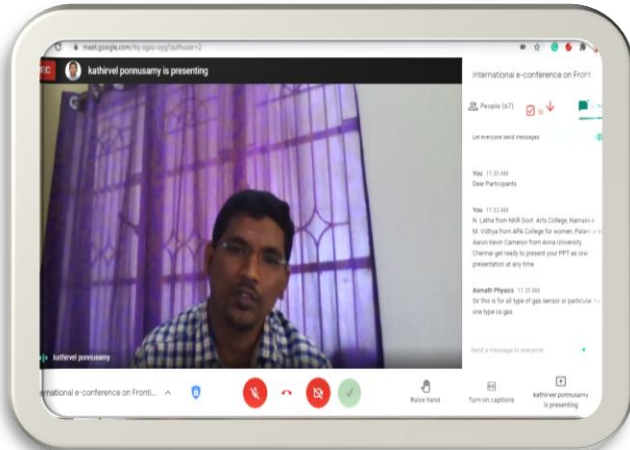

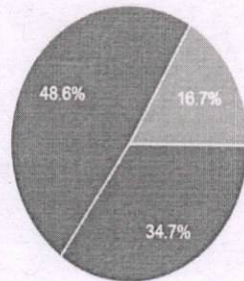

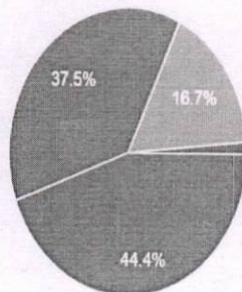

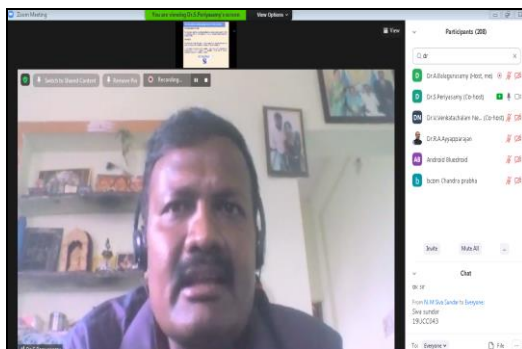
